

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND COMPETITION

- This Show is conducted subject to the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution and rules of this Society and any regulation which appears within the Schedule for individual sections of this Show. Should there be any conflict between the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution and rules of this society and the regulations appearing in any schedule, the constitution, rules and regulations appearing in the schedule of this Society shall prevail.
- All persons upon entering any class in this Schedule agree to indemnify the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY against liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to any Exhibit, Exhibitor or Competitor and agree that all Competitions are under the complete and total control of the IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY whose decision in all matters is final.
- Entrants must comply with the Queensland Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) Regulations Act 2011.
- Entrants agree to abide by COVID safe requirements and directions by the Ipswich Show Society Management and adhere to current Queensland COVID-19 restrictions as listed under the Chief Health Officer Public Health Directive.

THE IPSWICH SHOW SOCIETY

- Will appoint a Chief Steward to each section as its representative in all matters. Failure to comply with lawful directions from appointed Stewards, Committee or Staff or use of verbal or physical abuse will result in Disciplinary Action which may include exclusion from further Competitions and/or the Ipswich Showgrounds.
- Will appoint Judges whose decisions are final and for which no verbal or written communication will be accepted or entered into.
- Reserves the right to make any decisions, inclusions or changes to this Schedule including Conditions of Entry as it may deem fitting without further notice.
- Entering of Competitions does not constitute free admission entry into the Ipswich Show.
- By way of entering for this Competition exhibitors acknowledge that they are compliant with these Conditions.

ANIMAL/s AND BIRD/S EXHIBITORS

- All animal/s and bird/s exhibitors must sign an EXHIBIT HEALTH DECLARATION upon delivery of entry and must comply with the health requirements detailed in this document.
- Exhibit Health Declarations are available at the Show Office or Website www.ipswichshow.com.au
- All Veterinarian fees are the responsibility of the Owner of the animal. Ipswich Show will not take responsibility for any veterinarian fees.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY INTO GROUNDS

- No Glass is to be brought on the Grounds. (Other than entries into sections that require glass jars/bottles.)
- All electrical leads must be tagged in accordance with the relevant industrial regulations.

HORTICULTURE - RULES AND REGULATIONS

In conjunction with General Conditions of Entry & Competition:

- Exhibitors are requested to note that Judges will commence their work punctually and Exhibits not in position will not be considered.
- Exhibits may be removed between 8:30am and 11:00am Monday, 16th May 2022.
- With the exception of the Floral Section, all Exhibits must have been grown by the Exhibitor.
- Pot Plants must be the property of the Exhibitor for three (3) months and size of plants and pots must balance.
- Orchids must be owned and in possession of the Exhibitor for 6 months.
- Cut Flowers and Floral work will be staged in Bottles and Vases supplied by the Society. Bowls front view. Vases and Jugs to be supplied by the Exhibitor.
- Hanging Baskets to be judged according to foliage and growth.
- Exhibitors may enter more than one exhibit in each class.
- The Society will take every reasonable care of all exhibits in its possession, but will not be responsible for any damage thereto or loss thereof.
- In hearing of all protests arising out of entries not being in accordance with the rules of the Society. The decision of the Committee shall be final.
- All background material used in the displays to be in position and completed by 8:30pm Thursday, prior to show.



To enter visit: https://showday.online/ and register your account.




REGISTER

- 1. When visiting Showday online for the first time you will need to create an account. Single click the Register button. Complete your details and then single click the green Create New Account button.
- 2. You will need to have the correct punctuation, address info etc, as this information is how all the shows you enter (via Showday.online) will identify you. An individual show cannot change this information once they have received your entry and you are responsible to keep this information up to date on Showday.online.

- 3. You will receive a welcome email from Showday.online . Follow the directions and setup your Showday.online login password. Then single click the green Save button. If you do not receive this email, please contact Showday via their Contact link -https://showday.online/contact.
- 4. YOU MUST DO THIS TO ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT
- 5.Please do not create multiple accounts on Showday.online as each show will have information against accounts already created.

LOG IN AND ENTER

- 1. Once you have created your account, from the home page, click on the ALL EVENTS tab at the top of the page. A new page will load with a list of Shows, scroll down to Ipswich Show and select.
- 2. One the page loads click on the PLACE AN ENTRY on the top left to begin entering.



- 3. Click on Individual or Group Enty
- 4. Fill Entrant Add new entrant and enter your details
- 5.. Click on Name and Exhibit type
- 6. Select the Section and Classes you wish to enter
