CLUB STALLS

Clubs may sell plants (named, well established and pest & disease free), craft, or home-made goods eg. cakes, sweets, jams, preserves or other items (no used items). The stall site is free, and two tables & two chairs are provided. A commission of 10% on items sold will be payable to QCGC at the conclusion of the show. Complementary tea, coffee, and biscuits available for volunteers only. Volunteers to staff the stall on Saturday and Sunday <u>must</u> be registered for complementary entry – (up to 4 people per day).

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers are required in the following areas over three days.

- Friday set up, competition bench stewards
- Saturday competition bench stewards, raffle ticket sellers, refreshments sunday raffle ticket sellers, refreshments, clean up.

Volunteers will be allocated times based on preferences to ensure all times are covered and to avoid duplications. Confirmation of volunteer times will be forwarded to the contact person.

Volunteers <u>must</u> be registered to receive complementary entry. Complementary tea, coffee, and biscuits available.
